Dear Parents/Guardians,

This letter contains important information about **Nambour State College**

2026 Student Resource Scheme including how the scheme operates and the annual participation fee.

The Queensland Government supports students' education by providing funding for:

- Instruction, eg. teachers
- Facilities, eg. buildings, amenities, furniture
- Administration, eg. staffing and resources to administer the operations of the school.

Funding does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks, computer or musical equipment for personal use, and many items used/consumed by the student in the classroom. Supply of these items is the responsibility of parents.

To provide parents with a cost-effective alternative to purchasing textbooks and/or resources elsewhere, Nambour State College will again operate an SRS for 2026.

The scheme ensures that students have the resources required for them to engage with the curriculum for their education and saves parents time and money in sourcing the prescribed materials elsewhere. Savings are gained through the school's bulk purchasing practices and hiring arrangements. The scheme is not used to raise funds for other purposes, and revenue collected through the scheme is applied only to the resources and operation of the scheme.

The scheme's operation, resource inclusions and participation fees were approved by the school's P&C Association at the meeting held on 26/11/2025.

SRS Participation

The objective of the scheme is to provide a convenient and cost-effective way for students to access the educational resources necessary to enhance their learning experience at school. The Department encourages parents to participate in the scheme. Participation in the SRS is optional, and no obligation is placed on a parent to participate. Participation is for the duration of your child's enrolment at the school.

Parents are required to complete and return the SRS Participation Agreement Form when joining the scheme for the first time. If no participation form is received by the student's first day of school, the school will take the view that the parent has chosen to opt out of the SRS. The parent is then required to provide the educational resources listed in the SRS for their child by the start of the school year. A parent can opt in or out of the scheme in subsequent years by completing another Participation Agreement Form.

Resource Inclusions

All resources included in the SRS are detailed in the attached [SRS Resource list](#). This list is also available on the school's website. This is a comprehensive list of all resources included in the scheme and their associated costs.

Type of Resources Provided

The three types of resources that could be included are:

- **Owned** – these items are retained by the student and used as required (eg. stationery, exercise books, student diary).
- **Used** – these items are used/consumed in class by the student (eg. industry technology/cooking/art supplies).
 - work/items produced from these resources will remain the property of the student.
- **Hired** – these items are hired to the student for their personal use for a specific period (eg. textbooks, musical instruments and technology).

Costing Methodology

The Student Resource Scheme (SRS) fee is calculated as a flat fee for all students in the Senior School. This fee covers the cost of resources included in the scheme, as detailed in the attached SRS Resource List.

The SRS Participation Fee

The SRS fee payable for the year also includes the TRA component deducted to reduce the SRS fee payable.

The Textbook and Resource Allowance

The Department of Education provides a Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) to assist parents with the cost of textbooks and other education resources for eligible Years 7 to 12 students. For those students who are eligible to receive the TRA, the TRA will be applied to reduce the cost of participation in the SRS. Payment Arrangement

To ensure the smooth operation of the Student Resource Scheme, it is important that all fees are paid in full by the due dates. Parents are expected to adhere to the agreed payment arrangement

- either as a single payment by Week 2 of Term 1
- or via instalments due by Week 10 of each term.

Failure to maintain payments as scheduled may result in:

- The student being excluded from the scheme (resources will need to be provided by the parent).
- Restrictions on participation in non-curricular activities until outstanding amounts are cleared.

All unpaid invoices will be managed in accordance with the Department's Debt Management Procedure.

Payment Method

Our preferred payment options are QParents, BPOINT, BPAY, or Centrelink.

- QParents Portal: Payments can be made securely using a credit card through the QParents portal. The portal will direct you to BPOINT, where you can select the relevant outstanding invoice for payment.
- BPOINT: When paying directly via BPOINT, please ensure you use the Customer Reference Number (CRN) and invoice number printed on the invoice provided by the school.
- BPAY: BPAY payments can be made using your bank's online or phone banking service. Please use the Biller Code and Reference Number provided on your school invoice.

Financial Hardship Support

We understand that some families may experience financial difficulties. Parents who are currently participating in the SRS or wish to join but are facing hardship are encouraged to contact the school to discuss available options in confidence. The Principal is also available to meet with families to discuss individual circumstances and provide support where possible.
