This funding will be used to


- Fund key initiatives in our Explicit Improvement Agenda 2019.

- Provide funding for employment of teacher aides to run Levelled Literacy Intervention at the Junior Campus.
- Provision of funds to release staff for collaborative Planning & Conversations.
- Funding of additional staff to support future-focused initiatives and pathways connection for senior students.
- Fund additional learning engagement staff to work with identified students in years 7 – 9.
- Provide additional Guidance Officer/Chaplaincy support at key times throughout 2019.
- Purchase additional administration support to manage and monitor student attendance in collaboration with school staff.
- Investing in collegial staff professional learning processes to enhance professional growth and professional practice and support student learning.
- Purchase of Literacy and Numeracy HOC/Coaches to support capability in Literacy and Numeracy and a delivery of Literacy and Numeracy across the College.
